Example: KWohl (This is your USERNAME & PASSWORD)

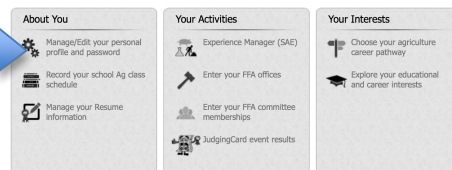
